Philanthropic Programs

Operation School Bell®, the signature program of National Assistance League, provides new school clothing to children from low income families. Last year ALPV clothed over 1,400 children, enabling them to attend school with enthusiasm and smiles on their faces. This program also provides new books to children of all ages. Since 2013 we have distributed over 5,500 books.

ALPV Dental Center provides emergency and routine dental care, including fluoride treatments, x-rays, and root canals. Over 150 children received 350 treatments in the 2018-2019 school year.

Assault Survivor Kits® provides new clothing, toiletries, and other items to women and children who are victims of trauma or assault. Kits are assembled by members of ALPV and distributed by Project Sister.

We have been working for children and their families in this community for over 74 years. Since 1986 our Dental Center has provided quality dental care to well over 15,000 children (with over 40,000 treatments) and, since 1998 our Operation School Bell program has provided new school clothing, at no cost, to over 22,000 children. For some of the children this is the first time they have had new school clothing.
